

Transformational Agreements Overview






There is increasing pressure being placed on the traditional subscription model, as policy and funder mandates favour routes towards open access publication



Transformational Agreements enable the migration of funding from reading towards publishing, whilst recognising that the subscription element still remains an important part of the agreement



Wiley is fully committed to the transition to open access, and Transformational Agreements are a key component of our open access strategy



Transformational Agreements - What's Next?






- Wiley currently has 103 agreements across the globe, covering 3000+ institutions and 90k+ articles
- This is a list of countries we are looking to partner with for future agreements to accelerate the transition to OA
- This includes countries in which we don't currently have an agreement, and countries where there is scope to increase existing coverage
- Not all countries and regions are suitable for a transformational agreement currently, whether due to policy, funding or historic subscription spending
- Please note this is indicative, and is not a guarantee that agreements will be signed, nor within a specific timeframe










TAs are the **framework** for a sustainable transition to OA that provides a **route to compliance** for authors without directly paying fees out of pocket






TA Article Coverage and OA Output in the Market



The number of articles covered by Transformational Agreements for each publisher is estimated based on publicly disclosed information regarding the agreements or from available data about the likely output. Authors can opt-out of open access in hybrid journals, so the number of articles published open access as a result of TAs may be less than the number offered.
